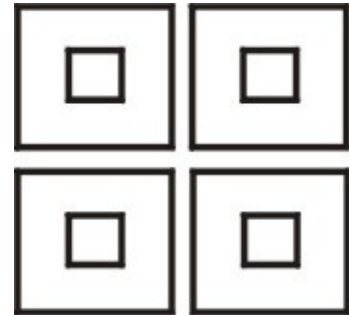

Yoshishige's father conducted a long term feud with Hoshino Chikatada, the ruler of Chikuzen, which is still unresolved.

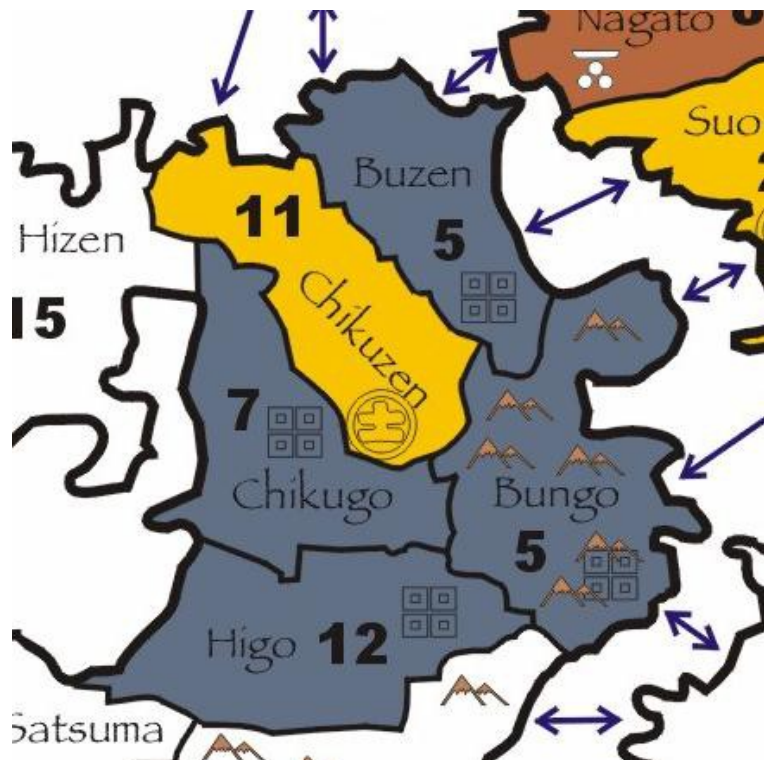

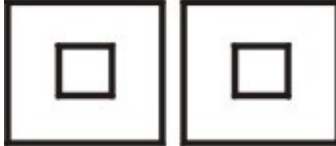
## Personal Briefing : Daimyo Otomo Yoshishige

tradition of control in this part of Japan.



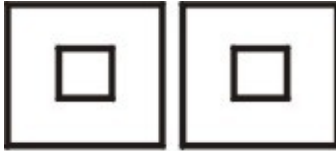

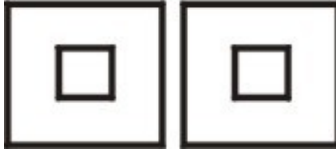

- d. If necessary, die an honourable death rather than be dishonoured, or fail in your objectives.



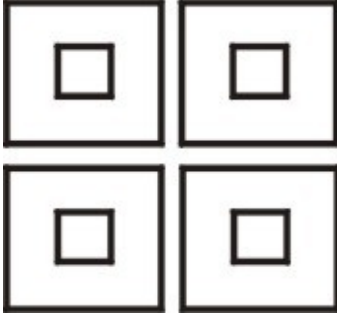

- d. You would like to increase your standing in the clan also - but obviously this should not be at the expense of the greater good of the clan itself.



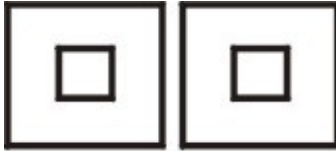

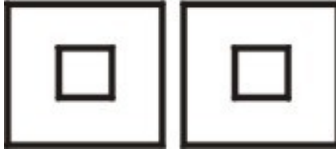

- c. That samurai from other clans become poorer (preferably in meeting objective b. above).



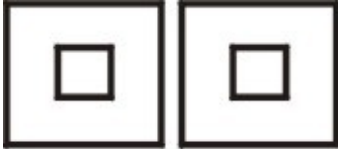

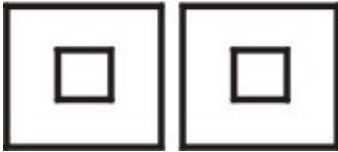
